PORTUGAL

No e-learning course, but some of SAI's auditors participated during 2013 in an e-learning course, promoted by the Brazilian Court of Auditors on the subject: "Governance in the public sector".

SPAIN

One e-learning course within the 2013 Training Program, *on the new "Public Accounting General Plan"* (approved by the Act of the Ministry of Finance on the 13th of April 2010).

The other courses included in the Training Program are given on-site.

E-learning on public auditing and accounting jurisdiction provided to the colleagues from the SAls of South America, through an online campus/platform, from 2005 to 2012 (see Spain's contribution in the Innovations Booklet). Unfortunately, due to budget restrictions of the funding institutions, the online training was not given in 2013 and it looks like it won't be given next year.

In addition, the Spanish Court of Audit's personnel can attend the training courses given by the *National Institute of Public Administration and the Institute of Fiscal Studies*. Both institutes offer e-learning courses on different topics of interest to SAI's employees but not especially focused on public auditing.

SWEDEN

Mainly two e-based courses:

- 1) As part of the Introduction program for newly recruited auditors/employees, a web-based course on the governmental organization is mandatory (the course is the same for all employees in the public sector).
- 2) An e-learning course on financial control has been created (with the assistance of external consultants) for internal use by the performance auditors. However, this course has not been completed due to budgetary restraints (highly priced licenses forced to step back, at least for the time being).
- 3) As chairman of FAS, the Swedish National Audit Office has also monitored, and contributed expertise to, the development of iCAT (ISSAI Compliance Assessment Tool) and an e-course to train ISSAI-facilitators.
