I. Executive summary

Strategic Goal (1)

CAPACITY BUILDING: Facilitate the development and the strengthening of institutional capacity of EUROSAI members

Main results achieved (2)

- SAI of Hungary took over the chairmanship from SAI of France during the IXth Congress (The Hague, 16-19 June 2014)
- SAI of the Netherlands joined GT1 as new EUROSAI presidency
- SAI of Turkey (upcoming EUROSAI presidency) joined GT1 as member
- Terms of Reference were modified due to the above mentioned change
- Operational plan reviewed by exchange of emails between chair and responsible SAIs and agreed in the 7TH GT1 meeting: some tasks were modified, some new tasks were added (Audits of municipalities, integrity-based self-assessment tools, "Delivering the message", Open data see more details in chapter 6 and chapter 8)
- GT1 Chair (SAI of Hungary) attended the INTOSAI Capacity Building committee (CBC) meeting in Peru, in September 2014, on behalf of EUROSAI. The 7 INTOSAI Regions presented their regional profile and participated in building a Joint CBC Work Plan 2014-2016 that contains strong partnership with the Regions.
- EUROSAI Secretariat extended one of the two invitations received from IDI to the EUROSAI to GT1 Chair. Both representatives, from the Secretariat and GT1 Chair, attended the IDI Planning & Prioritisation Meeting with INTOSAI Regions in December 2014 in Oslo.
- First meeting after the takeover the chairmanship held on 19-20 February, 2015 in Budapest, Hungary.

- Expand our knowledge of the international activity of the SAIs for dissemination
- Focus on good practices relating to dissemination of international activities within a SAI in order to maximize cross-fertilization
- Participation on IDI CB programmes of interest to our members (on cost recovery basis).
