



## **Invitation to EUROSAI Peer-to-Peer Capacity Building Workshop in the Netherlands 12– 14 February 2019**

### *What*

The SAIs of the Netherlands (NCA) and Sweden (SNAO), as co-leader of the Strategic Goal 2 (SG2), in cooperation with the INTOSAI Capacity Building Committee (CBC), aim to bring together EUROSAI members with extensive experience as providers of peer-to-peer support for a capacity building workshop in February 2019. This workshop is part of the project “Enhanced capacity for peer-to-peer support” foreseen in the SG2’s Operational Plan of the EUROSAI Strategic Plan 2017-2023.

### *Why*

The overall goal of the workshop is to explore possible ways of improving the quality and increasing the quantity of long-term peer-to-peer support. The focus of the workshop will be on project management and different project phases. The intended result of the workshop is to enhance capacity and approaches to provide effective long-term peer-to-peer support and an improved network among providers. The results will be shared in such a way that it can benefit a broader audience of potential providers of peer-to-peer support.

### *When/Where*

The EUROSAI Peer-to-Peer Capacity Building Workshop will be held in the Hague, the Netherlands. The workshop will be three days, starting on Tuesday afternoon the 12<sup>th</sup> of February and ending on Thursday the 14<sup>th</sup> of February.

### *Who*

The workshop targets SAIs with extensive experience in implementing long-term peer-to-peer capacity building projects (at least two long-term projects in the past 6 years) and participants with hands-on experience in the area. Interested EUROSAI members are requested to list their experience as part of the pre-registration process. Please note that the organizers will confirm your attendance provided you meet the criteria of participation. A total of 20 to 25 persons are expected to participate in the workshop (max. 2 persons from each SAI). The SAI experts will be joined for a session by Dutch representatives from institutions working in the field of peer-to-peer capacity building in order to learn from their approaches and experiences.

### *How*

The program design is aligned to the second strategic goal of the EUROSAI Strategic Plan 2017-2023: “*Helping SAIs deal with new opportunities and challenges by supporting and facilitating their institutional capacity development*”. The workshop particularly addresses objective 2.1: “*To facilitate and support needs-driven institutional capacity development initiatives*”. The program design will flow from an inspirational session on organisational learning and change management on the *first day*, getting down to sharing information on what the individual SAIs have done regarding project initiation, design, planning, execution and evaluation in peer-to-peer capacity building on the *second day*. The second day will also include an inspirational session with some Dutch organizations working in their own field of peer-to-peer capacity building. The workshop will end with forward looking perspectives (forward planning), which also includes identification of opportunities for further cooperation and best practices for broader dissemination within EUROSAI/INTOSAI.

Active preparation and participation are expected from all participants. We are looking forward to interesting and constructive days and the opportunity to learn from each other’s fantastic failures and sustainable successes.
